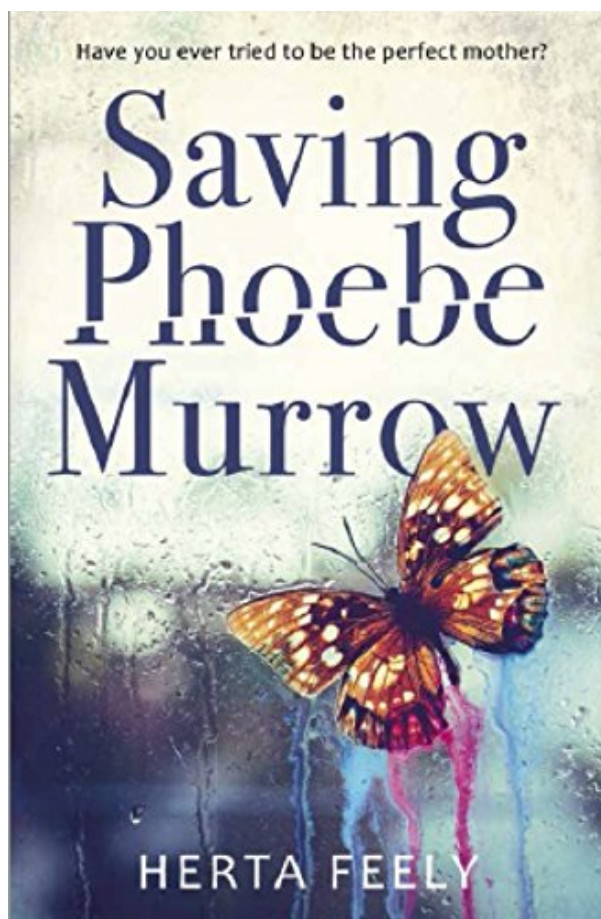

I could recommend this book for anyone--it's suspenseful and a quick read, but I'd particularly recommend it for parents, as it deals with social media, and the new threats our children face that I had never really considered. It's set in the world of private-school Washington DC, so anyone with a connection to the DC area will enjoy the local culture and references. We get to view this world through the eyes of anxious parents--anxious for social status, popular kids, and loving relationships with their own (or other's!) spouses AND through the eyes of their teenage children just beginning high school. It kind of took me back to what it feels like to be 14 and how our inner voice is almost completely determined by our peer group.
