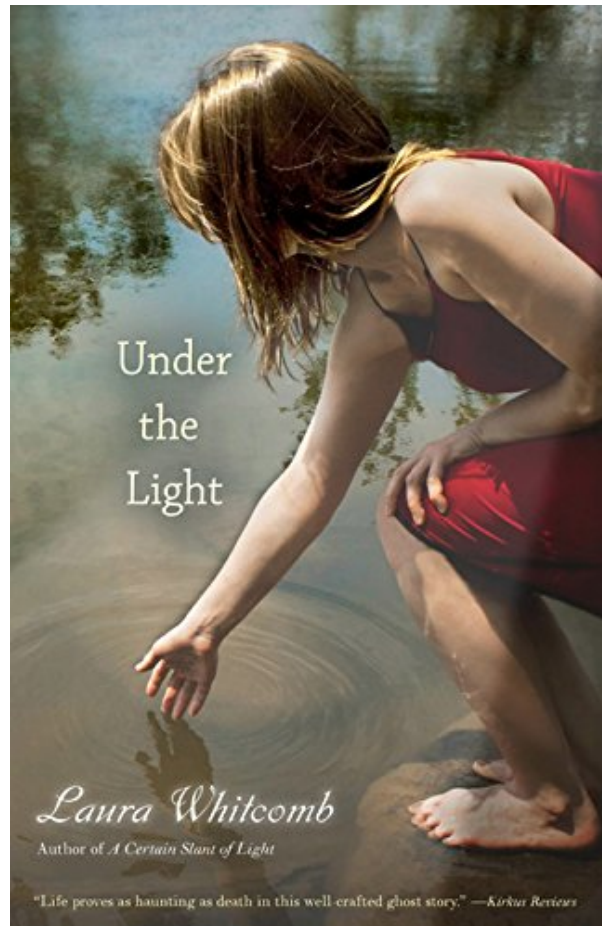
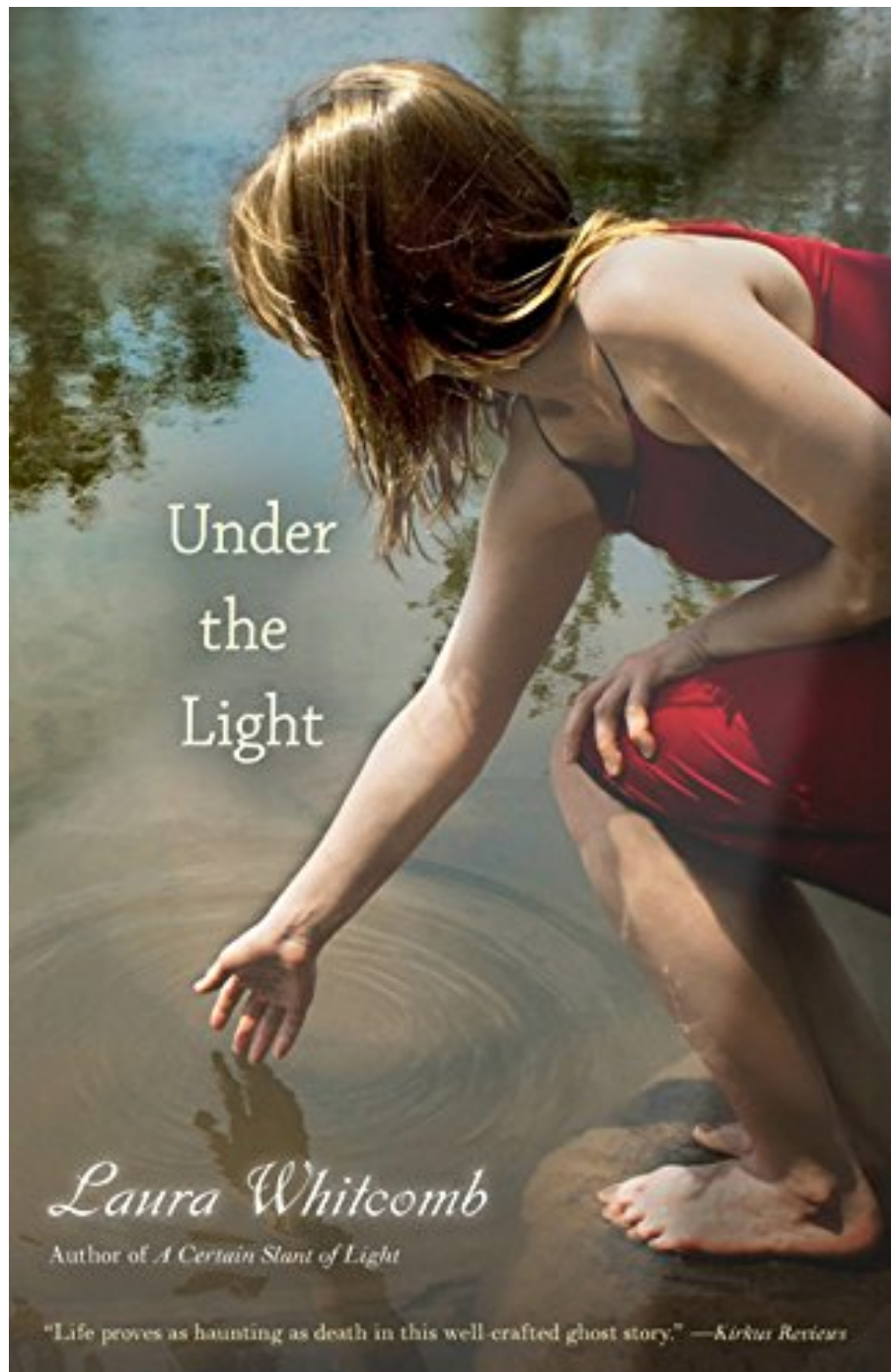

Don't get me wrong, Ms. Whitcomb is an extremely gifted writer. Her writing style is so poetic, it's hard to believe her novels were written in this century and not in centuries past. However, I just couldn't suspend my disbelief enough to immerse myself in the plotlines presented in this novel. The two spirits in the field/shooting star scene was so cheesy that I found myself rolling my eyes as I read it. I would not have expected such a scene to be included in this book, since its predecessor, though YA like "Under the Light", had scenes in it that were clearly intended for a much more mature reader. Therefore, while I highly recommend A Certain Slant of Light, I cannot say the same for its sequel.
