

This book is very thorough. Christians who consider themselves experts (but won't read the book) could learn a lot from it. For example, in response to Tinker's four star review, Arden (who considers himself a knowledgeable Christian scholar) lectures her on the Adam and Eve account in Genesis and accuses her of

putting her "own slant on" Scripture when she says womankind was blamed for the fall of man. Arden gets Genesis right - that only Adam was directly warned, and had he read "Woe to the Woman," he would have found that's the way Annie Laurie covered it too (second and third pages of the first chapter (Creation - Eve was framed). But Tinker is right that womankind is held accountable by the scriptures: Here is last paragraph from that chapter: "The myth of Adam and Eve is thrown back into the faces of women countless times by the New Testament writers. Timothy epitomizes the way in which the story was exploited in order to oppress and blame women: 'Let the woman learn in silence with all subjection. But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence. For Adam was first formed, then Eve. And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression."' 1 Timothy 2:11-14.
